The Managing Committee is totally committed to support the ongoing efforts of the Government and the Health Authorities in whatever way we can contribute towards their efforts to fight this pandemic. I am confident that the Members will agree with our decision to stand united and support this humanitarian cause.

We at the Gymkhana hope and pray that all individuals admitted to the Gymkhana for treatment and care will leave the premises completely cured. Patients and their family will remember the Gymkhana forever which in turn will bring Showers of Blessings to the institution.

I take this opportunity to thank our Labour Advisor, Advocate Lancy D'Souza for the unstinted support he extends to the Gymkhana. I wish to thank our Vice-President Rajesh D'Souza, Hon. Let us not panic, let us be prudent. Take care. Stay safe and keep well. Hope to meet all of you at the Gymkhana once things are back to normal.


