KNOWLEDGE WORTH HAVING BY DR. KIRAN COELHO HELD ON 1ST DECEMBER, 2019

Continuing the "Knowledge Worth Having" series, the Managing Committee organised a talk by Dr. Kiran Coelho on the topic "Recent Advances in Women's Health Care" covering gynaecological issues faced by women of all ages. Dr. Coelho is highly respected and renowned in the field of Obstetrics & Gynaecology and it was indeed an honour to have her address our members and guests.





A vast number of topics were covered and her presentation answered questions without being voiced! These ranged from symptoms, diagnosis and treatment of Polycystic Ovarian Disorder, Infertility, Infections, Menopause and various cancers. As a Gynaecologist, Dr. Coelho laid out all options available. However, being a Catholic Gynaecologist on the Archdiocesan panel and lecturing to Seminarians, Dr. Coelho clearly presented the Church's stand on some

of the options and explained the Church's viewpoint on why and what is not permitted. Many of the Infertility treatment options fall in this category as they involve artificial fertilisation procedures. Additionally, this gives rise to ethical issues as extra-fertilised cells (after Conception) are destroyed. This is definitely information that we as Catholics need to have!!

Dr. Coelho also stated she had never conducted an abortion precisely for this reason. Dr. Coelho also advised that hysterectomies should be performed only if strictly required and that removal of ovaries should be avoided. Dr. Coelho's presentation ended with a question-answer session where doubts were clarified. It was heartening to see many male members attend and even ask questions – indicating their love and concern for their mothers, wives, sisters and daughters.


